Applications are now available for the City of Peterborough Low Income Senior & Low Income Property Tax Assistance Program

Peterborough, ON – Applications are now available for the City of Peterborough Low Income Senior & Low Income Property Tax Assistance Program. Applications are online at www.peterborough.ca or at the City Hall Tax Office, 500 George St. N. Those that received tax credits in 2018 will automatically receive a 2019 Property Tax Assistance application in the mail.

Qualifying applicants will receive a \$400 tax credit on their tax accounts which will be applied to the February 2019 Interim tax bill. Those applicants who previously received more than a \$400 credit will be grandfathered in at their higher credit amount.

Applicants can apply under one of the following qualifications:

- 1. Low Income Senior aged 65 years or older
- 2. Low Income Senior aged 55-64 years of age
- 3. Low Income Person with a Disability receiving benefits under the Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP).

The application deadline is February 15, 2019.
