### **Applications are now available for the City of Peterborough Low Income Senior & Low Income Property Tax Assistance Program**

Peterborough, ON – Applications are now available for the City of Peterborough Low Income Senior & Low Income Property Tax Assistance Program. Applications are online at [www.peterborough.ca](http://www.peterborough.ca) or at the City Hall Tax Office, 500 George St. N. Those that received tax credits in 2018 will automatically receive a 2019 Property Tax Assistance application in the mail.

Qualifying applicants will receive a \$400 tax credit on their tax accounts which will be applied to the February 2019 Interim tax bill. Those applicants who previously received more than a \$400 credit will be grandfathered in at their higher credit amount.

Applicants can apply under one of the following qualifications:

1. Low Income Senior aged 65 years or older
2. Low Income Senior aged 55-64 years of age
3. Low Income Person with a Disability receiving benefits under the Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP).

The application deadline is February 15, 2019.
